

1: WASH TUB

- Hot water
- A few drops of biodegradable dish soap
- A sponge

The water in this tub should be noticeably sudsy, but not so sudsy that the rinse tub next to it is becoming sudsy also.

When the water becomes full of floaty food bits, pour out the dirty dish water either in a designated area such as a drain, or by dispersing 200 feet (60 m) away from camp and water sources.

When all the dishes are done, pour out the water as above, rinse out remaining suds, and put back on the dish line upside down to signal that the dish line is closed.

2: RINSE TUB

- Hot water

When the water becomes full of floaty food bits or suds, pour out the dirty rinse water either in a designated area such as a drain, or by dispersing 200 feet (60 m) away from camp and water sources.

When all the dishes are done, pour out the water as above and put back on the dish line upside down to signal that the dish line is closed.

3: DISINFECTANT TUB

- Cold water and 3 Tbsp bleach

3 Tbsp is marked with black marker on the small measuring cup in the dish soap and bleach tray.

Rinse your hands after handling the bleach and take care to not get it anywhere else on you or others.

If the water becomes full of floaty food bits or suds, pour out the dirty rinse water either in a designated area such as a drain, or by dispersing 200 feet (60 m) away from camp and water sources.

When all the dishes are done, pour out the water as above and put back on the dish line upside down to signal that the dish line is closed.
